- In unprepared sections: guidance from parents, coaches or teachers will not be permitted. Breaching this rule will lead to the disqualification of the entire participating school.

- Speakers are not allowed to present the same speech more than once a year. A new year means new content.
- · All participants must be dressed in school uniform. Only the *Oppie Tong Af/ On The Tip Of Your Tongue* badge is permitted to be worn. No achievement pins or colours are allowed.
- · All entries will be completed and paid for electronically on the *Oppie Tong Af/ On The Tip Of Your Tongue* web page. This payment link is located under the Enrollment tab.
- · No email entries will be accepted.
- · No entry will be accepted without the participant's name and specified topic.
- · Ensure that you enter under the correct sections.
- · Groups in this instance are defined as 4 participants.
- · Fees will not be refunded should an entry not comply with the **Oppie Tong Af/ On The Tip Of Your Tongue** rules. These fees will, in this instance, be regarded as a donation towards the project.
- · Participants are permitted to take part in both prepared and unprepared sections.





### General Pules 3/63

- No unprepared questions will be asked under prepared sections. The adjudicators will only evaluate the prepared speech.
- One speech with the same content will not be permitted under multiple sections or under different language categories.
- · Individuals are limited to a maximum of four entries.
- · A R150.00 fee will be charged if the speaking times in an existing programme change.
- · If an allocated speaking time is changed, outside of an age group, the speaker/s will not be taken into consideration and will not be invited to the National final.
- Oppie Tong Af/ On The Tip Of Your Tongue organisers are authorised to make changes to the programme.
- · If you are scheduled in the programme, you are not permitted to swap or replace your scheduled time with other speakers.
- · Creative and pure language is encouraged.
- Foul language is not permitted nor tolerated.
- · Adjudicators reserve the right to a feedback session after each section as indicated on the program.
- · The adjudicator's decision remains final.







- · In 2023 there will only be one "LIVE" online competition in each province.
- The number of speakers invited to the National final event within each province will be determined by the amount of entries received within that specific province.
